Dip Netting Adventures and Nature Walk

Program Date: July 20th, 2016

Program Details:

We will begin our program at the DuPont Nature Center, allowing participants to view and explore our live critters and exhibits before heading outside into the field. We will then take a short walk to the bridge. There participants will work together in teams to identify different types of wildlife living here in the Delaware Bay estuary and surrounding areas by using a dip net and a bucket to catch live critters at the Cedar Creek bridge and boat ramp. During our walk to the boat ramp participants will use binoculars to spot and identify wildlife as well as pick up trash along the road to help keep our wildlife safe. Participants will learn more about the importance of the salt marsh ecosystem and how to identify different types of wildlife within our estuary and surrounding areas.
