

Affidavit for Absentee Ballot Request Instructions

General Instructions

1. You must fill out the affidavit prior to receiving your absentee ballot.
2. Affidavits no longer need to be notarized.
3. Affidavits received after 12:00 p.m. (noon) on June 24, 2020 will not have absentee ballots mailed to them, but they may be attained in person.
4. The last day to request affidavits is July 3, 2020. None will be accepted after that.
5. Affidavits may be mailed to the Town at 357 Bay Avenue, Slaughter Beach DE 19963-4909 or emailed to the town at townofslaughterbeach.comcast.net.

Special Considerations for Covid-19

On March 24, 2020 Governor John C. Carney modified his State of Emergency to address elections and Covid-19. His modification states that the term “sick, or physically disabled shall apply to and include any such voter who is asymptomatic of Covid-19 infection and otherwise abiding by CDC and DPH guidelines by exercising self-quarantine or social distancing to avoid potential exposure to (and community spread of) Covid-19, and who herself or himself freely chooses to use such qualifications to vote by absentee ballot.”
