



Notice of Solicitation of Candidates for Town Council

May 12, 2020

The Town Slaughter Beach has three seats on the Town Council up for election this year. The seats of Kathy Lock, Bob Wood, and Gary Plescia all expire this year. Each seat has a term of two years.

Anyone desiring to run for one of these three seats must file a Candidate Filing Form stating that they meet all qualifications for office. Candidate filing forms may be obtained from the Town by calling (302) 424-7659 or emailing townofslaughterbeach@comcast.net. Candidate filing forms can also be found on the town website www.slaughterbeach.delaware.gov. Candidate filing forms shall be filed by 5:00 p.m. on June 5 at the Town's office located at 357 Bay Ave., Slaughter Beach, and no Candidate Filing Forms will be accepted after this deadline.

To be an eligible candidate for Town Council you must:

- be at least 21 years of age;**
- not have been convicted of a felony or crime of moral turpitude;**
- be a citizen of the United States as of June 30, 2020.**
- Have been either domiciled in Slaughter Beach or a freeholder (property owner) in Slaughter Beach since January 1, 2020.**

An individual wishing to vote by absentee ballot must request an absentee ballot by filing an affidavit of qualifications with the Town no later than 12:00 p.m. (noon) June 24th. Absentee ballots may be requested through the town website, or by writing to the Town at 357 Bay Avenue, Slaughter Beach DE 19963-4909 or by telephone at (302) 424-7659, or by sending an email to townofslaughterbeach.comcast.net. For those affidavits received prior to 12:00 p.m. on June 24th, the Town will mail out absentee ballots. For affidavits received after 12:00 p.m. on June 24th, the individual filing the affidavit will be responsible for picking up the absentee ballot from the Town in person.
