RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SLAUGHTER BEACH APPROVING DRAFT LEGISLATION TO ESTABLISH ANNEXATION PROCEDURES AND SENDING THE DRAFT LEGISLATION TO SENATOR WILSON AND REPRESENTATIVE SHUPE

WHEREAS, in 1993, the General Assembly adopted "An Act to Reincorporate the Town of Slaughter Beach," which act is located in Chapter 150, Volume 69, Laws of Delaware; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that an amendment to the Charter enacted by the General Assembly in 1993 is necessary and essential in order to incorporate annexation procedures into the Charter of the Town of Slaughter Beach, which powers are standard powers found in most municipal charters in Delaware.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Slaughter Beach, a majority thereof concurring in Council duly met, that the Town Charter of the Town of Slaughter Beach, Chapter 150, Volume 69, Laws of Delaware, as amended, be recommended to the Delaware General Assembly for amendment in accordance with the draft bill attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the draft bill approved by the Town Council be sent to Senator David L. Wilson and Representative Bryan W. Shupe for their sponsorship and support during the 152nd session of the General Assembly.
